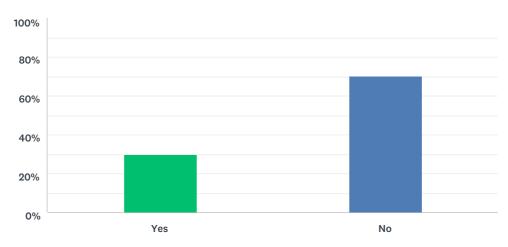

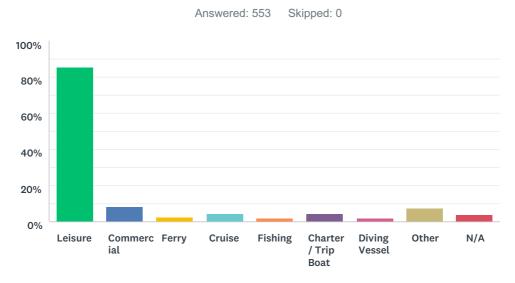

Q3 Which type of vessel or business do you operate or represent? Please tick all that apply.



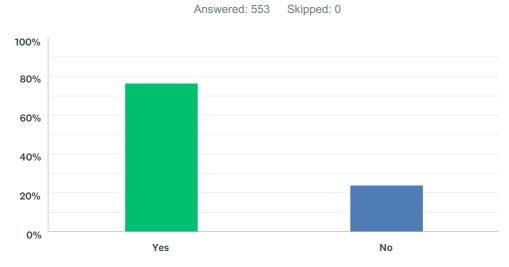

Q4 Have you looked at the Oban Harbour Website in the last 4 months



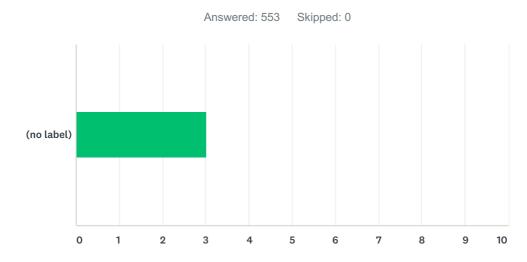

Q5 Are you aware of the work of the Oban Bay Management Group?



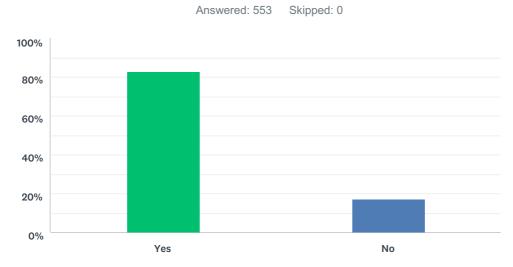

Q6 How would you rate the quality of information provided by the Oban Bay Management Group? 1 poor 5 good



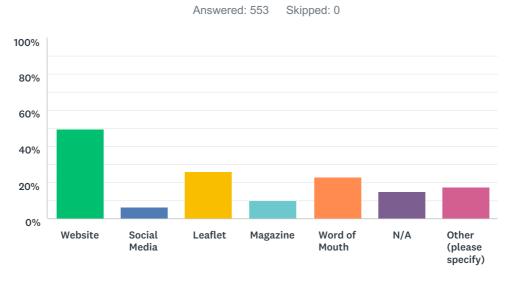

Q7 Are you familiar with the Oban Bay Code of Practice?



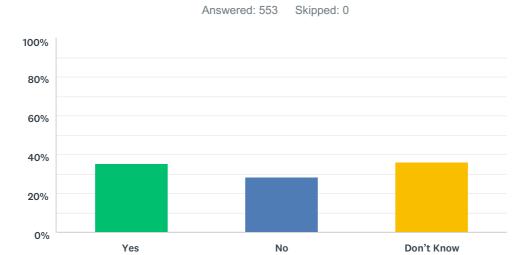

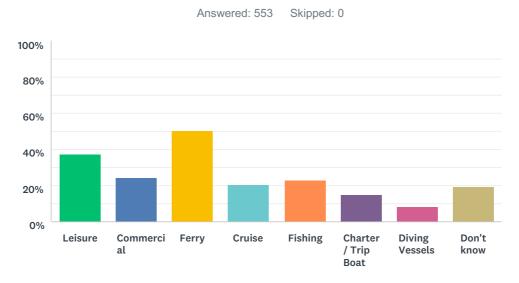

Q9 Will a statutory harbour authority for Oban Bay be beneficial to navigational safety



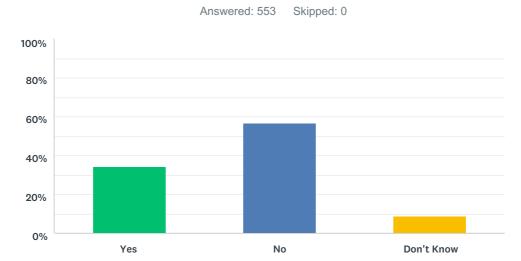

Q10 What type of vessel or vessels cause the greatest safety risk at Oban? Please tick all that apply.



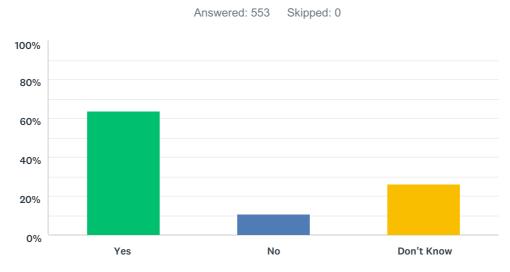

Q11 Does Oban Bay require better Aids to Navigation (buoyage, lights etc.)?



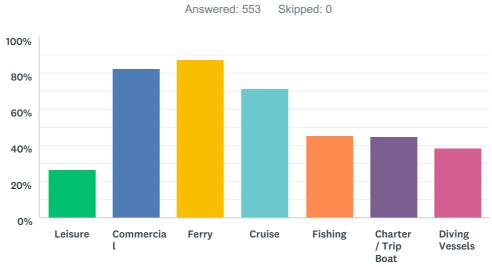

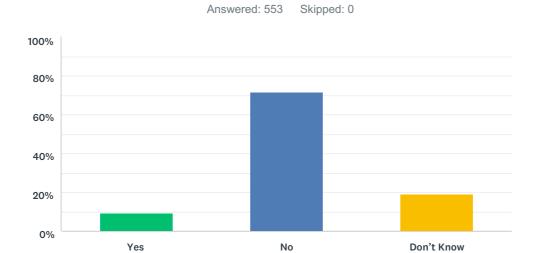
